

The Fastest-Growing Jobs And Careers For The Next Decade

The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) releases monthly data about employment creation in the United States. This report carries a lot of information and statistics about jobs and careers. Recently, the BLS put together a list of the fastest growing jobs for the next 10 years and how much they pay. Broadly speaking, most of these jobs can be segregated into 4 major categories as follows:

HOSPITALITY & LEISURE



The hospitality sector was the first to bear the brunt of COVID-19, with the industry almost shut down entirely for an extended period of time. As the country gradually reopens, the travel & tourism industry is expected to bounce back to its former glory. This sector will see huge demand and jobs will be available in plenty.

HEALTHCARE

The pandemic and its increased awareness among people has ensured that healthcare and allied services will generate a large number of jobs in the coming years. In addition, higher life expectancies coupled with an aging baby-boomer generation has led to a significant increase in the demand for doctors, nurses and other medical staff.

TECHNOLOGY



COVID-19 has only reiterated the fact that technological advancements are necessary to keep the world moving in difficult situations. Hence, moving forward, we can expect organizations to invest heavily in digital transformation, AI, robotics etc. Strong demand is anticipated in the IT security, software development, gaming and data sciences sectors.

CLEAN ENERGY

As the world realizes the importance of environmentally-friendly energy sources, the focus will shift towards the use of renewable source of power like wind and solar energy. This will lead to a spurt of jobs in these sectors within the next decade.
